A Cadetship with SRJ Walker Wayland is offered for any year 12 or first year university students who are citizens or permanent residents of Australia to apply. Students will be enrolling (and subsequently accepted) at a recognised university for 2023 into a Business, Commerce or dual degree. It is not necessary to be undertaking an Accounting major. Enrolment of the individual for the course of tertiary study will initially be on a part-time basis, with a maximum of 2 subjects per semester upon commencement of a cadetship.
